

At Earth Animal, we recognize the invaluable role that animals play in our lives and in our learning environments. The Dogs in the Classroom and Pets in the Classroom programs embody this philosophy through generous grants that enable educators to integrate the nurturing presence of animals into classrooms, thereby enriching their students' educational journeys.

In collaboration with leading national therapy dog organizations, the Dogs in the Classroom program brings trained therapy dogs into classrooms. Similarly, the Pets in the Classroom program offers financial support to teachers for the acquisition and care of small animals within the educational setting.

Classroom pets provide a unique opportunity to nurture the human-animal bond, benefiting the students, teachers, and the pets themselves. They serve as living lessons in responsible pet care, shaping students into informed and compassionate handlers. Notably, with half of the classrooms supported by these programs being in high-poverty Title 1 schools, these initiatives offer invaluable experiences to children who might otherwise not have the opportunity to interact with or care for pets.
